



## ALTERED FRAME - MY PROM

### Supplies:

**The ScrapBook Diva:**

Purple Passion Leopard paper

### Mermaid Tears:

Pink Japanese Rice Paper

Purple Prom Diva

Pink Nailheads

Lavender set of dogwood flowers

Rhinestones

Silver page jewelry

Black jewels

### Other Supplies:

Lavender Polished Stone paper (Murdock Country Creations)

Black Kromkote paper

Vellum

Silver leafing Pen (Krylon)

Love Letters 4 corner rub ons (Beary Patch)

My Prom Letters – hand cut

Scrolled stamp (Stampin Up)

Black embossing powder (Ranger)

Diamond Dust embossing powder (Judi Kins)

Frame



### Directions:

1. From the purple passion leopard paper cut a piece of paper to fit exactly over your frame. In this case my frame size was an 8" x 10". Cut out the area where your picture will show and adhere to your frame.
2. Tear a piece of Japanese paper by wetting a vertical line and pulling apart. (For further instructions on this technique see the Mermaid Tears website) Adhere this to the left side of your frame.
3. Cut the letter "My Prom" from the lavender sheet of polished stone paper. Create shadows for these letters with the black Kromkote. If you have stencils or a die cutting system feel free to use those also. Adhere the letters to their shadows and adhere to the frame on the left side at the top and bottom. (Refer to picture for placement)
4. Cut two corner scrolls from the love words 4 collection and rub them onto the right upper and lower corners of your frame.
5. Prepare your Prom Diva according to the directions and place on your frame to the right side. If you wish to add decoration to her gown simply use the scrolled stamp, stamp in Versa Mark and emboss with a mixture of black & diamond dust embossing powders. Heat to set
6. Take your set of three dogwood flowers and adhere those to the left side of the frame on your rice paper border. Place rhinestones in the center if desired.
7. To create the crown at the top of the frame use 8 nailheads. Depending on the hardness of your frame you may be able to push these into place. If not, simply bend the prongs inward and adhere to the frame with mini glue dots, placing three nailheads on the bottom, 4 in the middle in small semi-circle and one at the top.
8. Use 8 more nailheads and adhere them to the right side of your photo opening for further bling. Prepare two silver page jewelry pieces by gluing a black jewel in the center. Adhere them to your frame.
9. Print a computer generated or stamped saying on your vellum. Cut out and adhere saying to a small piece of black kromkote. Edge the kromkote with a silver leafing pen and glue to your frame.
10. To give that added touch of pizzazz use your silver leafing pen to edge the inner space of the open photo area.

**TIPS:** To give your frame added dimension place some of your pieces slightly off the frame.
